### **Support for Kuba**

'Kuba Kolek, aged 4, dreams of running like other children. He has a chance to do so if his family can raise more than £63,000 for specialist surgery. His parents Karina and Paweł from Wester Hailes rushed him to the Sick Kids hospital after he fell ill in October 2016. Doctors told them he had sepsis and his fingers and toes had to be amputated a few weeks later. The doctors did their best but Kuba's condition is getting worse and specialist help is needed. The operation can be carried out by an American expert who will restore Kuba's ability to walk. The procedure would be performed in Poland at a cost in excess of £63,000. This is a huge amount but it is much cheaper than if the operation were to take place in USA. This is the only chance for Kuba to function like other kids and by April 2020 they have to collect the money.'

Kuba's plight has been discussed at recent PPC meetings and the following has been agreed; A **Cake Sale** will take place following both Masses on **Sunday 26 February**.

A **Special Collection** will be taken up on **Sunday 23 February**.

It is hoped these two events will give parishioners the opportunity to support Kuba as they so wish.
